



🏠 Telehealth + Smart Home Checklist

A Senior's First-Week Guide for Safe, Simple, and Verified Setup



Pre-Setup Essentials

- Reliable Wi-Fi with tested signal in video-visit room.
- Backup power (UPS) for router + modem.
- Device PINs created, stored securely on a private card.
- Patient portal login tested and saved.
- Caregiver permissions configured (view-only if possible).

Smart Display / Telehealth Hub

- Large screen (≥8"), captions turned on, volume tested.
- L Doctor's office added as a favorite contact.
- a Camera shutter/cover operational.
- "Start my appointment" routine created (lights on, TV off, Do Not Disturb).
- Emergency contacts pre-loaded.

Remote Health Devices

- Blood pressure cuff paired and synced.
- Pulse oximeter paired and synced.
- Weight scale paired and synced.
- Glucose monitor paired and synced (if applicable).
- 📡 Data verified in clinic portal.





Safety & Emergency

Bathroom panic button installed at seated + standing height.

Hallway/bedroom fall detection sensor tested.

Wearable SOS pendant paired and functional.

To Weekly SOS test scheduled.

Contact tree verified (alerts go to correct person).

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Comfort & Environment

Smart lights tested for clear appointment visibility.

Thermostat comfort routine set.

Doorbell silenced automatically during visits.

Accessibility features (large text, bold fonts) enabled.

🦒 Seating optimized for camera angle + lighting.

First-Week Test Plan

Day 1: Pair devices + test family call.

Day 2: Sync vitals to portal; confirm upload.

Day 3: Mock telehealth appointment using full routine.

Day 4: Bathroom SOS button test (silent mode).

Day 5: Adjust captions, lighting, and speaker settings.

Day 6: Update firmware/apps; recheck Wi-Fi signal.

Day 7: Review → simplify/remove confusing steps.



Privacy & Safety Checklist

Rhare health data only in official apps/portals.

Lock screens + set device PINs.

Disable unnecessary "drop-in" features.

Run updates monthly.

Review caregiver access every quarter.

Validation Steps

Setup completed in ≤10 minutes.

Accessibility (captions, large fonts) enabled.

SSS Backup systems verified (SOS, UPS).

→ Clinic portal compatibility tested.

Quick-start sheet printed + placed by display.
